Lions Quest *Skills for Growing (K-5), Skills for Adolescence (6-8) and Skills for Action (9-12) Workshop Goals:*

- To examine ways a classroom and school-wide learning community can support the development of capable, healthy, young people of strong character.
- To learn how Lions Quest programs address the key elements of positive youth development, including the integration of social and emotional learning, prevention, character education, and service-learning.
- To understand and experience program components and materials.
- To explore the implementation possibilities for the classroom and school-wide learning community.

Skills for Growing (SFG)

Through a series of six thematic units, SFG will help create a classroom environment that nurtures and enhances learning. The curriculum includes life skills and citizenship units, multidisciplinary activities, a variety of implementation models, drug information guide, school climate guide and parent meeting guide.

Skills for Adolescence (SFA)

SFA helps middle school youth, parents and teachers cope with the physical, emotional and social challenges of the early adolescent years. The program builds important competencies by promoting positive social attitudes, respect, and responsibility, while serving as a strong prevention tool.

Skills for Action (SFC)

The SFC development of personal, social, and thinking skills, combined with service learning, helps young people gain school-to-work competencies, improve self confidence, build resilience, maintain commitment to school, and promote social and cultural understanding.
